A professor of Biotechnology at the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Roorkee, Pranita P Sarangi, has bagged the Innovative Young Biotechnologist Award (IYBA) for 2017.

The IYBA award covers a research grant up to Rs 50 lakh and a cash award prize of Rs 1 lakh per year during the project period.

Sarangi was chosen for the award for her scientific achievements and proposed work in the field of cancer immunology.
