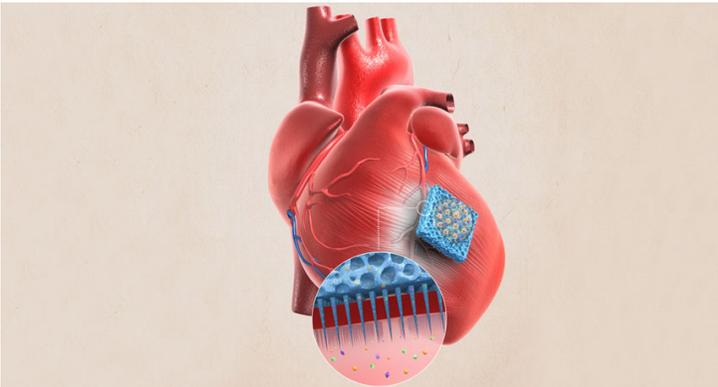


Edwards' SAPIEN 3 Ultra Transcatheter Heart Valve gets FDA nod
