

Aura Air unveils smart air-purifiers in India

Aura Air air-purifiers have been clinically certified for their effectiveness against the SARS-CoV-2 virus



Aura Air, a publicly listed company with the Tel-Aviv Stock Exchange (TASE), has launched its smart air management platform in India. Aura Air air-purifiers detect, capture, and kill viruses, bacteria, mold and can remove airborne particles as small as 0.3 microns, including allergens and viruses. These IoT-enabled devices connect to a mobile phone and deliver real-time updates on the overall indoor and outdoor Air Quality Index (AQI) based on VOC (Volatile Organic Compounds), CO₂ (Carbon Dioxide), CO (Carbon Monoxide), and fine particulate matter levels.

Aura Air purifiers have successfully cleared clinical trials confirming their effectiveness against the corona virus in a study conducted at Sheba Medical Center and the results have been published in the world *Journal of Surgery and Surgical Research*. Aura Air is also in the process of getting Food and Drug Administration, USA approval.
