

## Oxymed unveils new 5 LPM oxygen concentrator

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Oxymed, one of India's most trusted names in home oxygen concentrators, has announced the launch of Oxymed Cure, a new 5 LPM oxygen concentrator designed to make reliable oxygen therapy more affordable without compromising on medical or service standards.

Oxymed Cure delivers medical-grade oxygen purity of 93%  $\pm$ 3%, in line with global standards. It features a built-in Oxygen Purity Analyzer (OPA) that allows users to monitor real-time oxygen purity, along with an integrated nebulizer for added

clinical convenience. The concentrator also offers improved energy efficiency, consuming approximately 200 watts, significantly lower than earlier models, and does not require a stabiliser.

Designed for home comfort, Oxymed Cure features a modern, premium design with a larger display, a sturdier build, and quieter operation at around 35 dB. Backed by Oxymed's PAN-India service network, the launch positions Cure as a strong alternative to low-cost imported concentrators that often come with limited warranty and service support.
